





Install the windows as described in the Origin Installation Guide





Ensure the remaining aperature is 6mm wider than the overall door set width

Do not install the glass



Install the alignment block into the window frame







Leave 200mm from each end and evenly space the rest appropriately




Drill, countersink and fix alignment blocks









Cut down 5mm frame packers to 72mm (one for each jamb packer)













Ensure packers are positioned next to the alignment blocks

Re-position the jamb packers in the jamb






Ensure packers are spaced the same as the frame packers installed on the window frame and fix appropriately




Position the door frame into the aperature and pack/clamp accordingly






Pre-drill the frame with a 3mm drill bit, as shown, for every alignment block used




Using supplied screws, fix the window frame to the door jamb









Seal the joint, between the window and door frame, making sure the joint is completely weather proof
